

Teaching Methodology


Backlog Clearance & cope-Up-Classes

APEX Education All India Test Series

These are IIT-JEE/PMT pattern tests. The test series will consist 18 tests (six for each subjects syllabus based) & 10 full syllabus test based on the latest IIT-JEE/PMT pattern. There will be one question paper of three hours duration for JEE (main)/PMT and two papers each of three hours duration for JEE (Advanced). Admission into IITs and some other institutes of National repute like ISM, Dhanbad and IIT-BHU was being made on the merit list prepared on the score of the IIT-JEE conducted till the year 2013. On the other hand All India Engineering Entrance Exam abbreviated as AIEEE being conducted by Central Board of Secondary Educations (CBSE) to prepare merit list for admission into National Institute of Technologies (NITs), IITs and other central funded institutes

For Appearing at IIT-JEE a candidate has to satisfy all the eligibility conditions given below

- ✦ A candidate can attempt JEE only twice, in consecutive years. The first attempt must be in the year he/she appears/passes XII Examination and the second attempt just the next year
- ✦ Candidates appearing at the JEE should have either passed the qualifying examination (XII Board Exam) in the previous year or be appearing in current year. They should also satisfy the criterion of securing a minimum of 60% marks in the aggregate of XII Board marks
- ✦ Candidate should NOT have accepted admission by paying full fees at any of the IITs IT-BHU, Varanasi or ISMU, Dhanbad, through earlier JEE.
- ✦ However, IIT-JEE & AIEEE have been combined together to form a single national level engineering admission test. The combined test has been named as Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) to be detailed soon. This JEE will be effective from the year 2013

NITs - A Glimpse

The National Institutes of Technology (NITs) are also highly prestigious Engineering Institutes of India. There are in all thirty (NITs - one in each major state/union territory of India. They are all autonomous institutes. Decades back when these NITs came into being they were referred to as Regional Engineering Colleges (RECs)/Regional Institutes of Technology (RIT) and were under the direct control of their respective State Governments. The motive behind setting up these institutes of Engineering was to promote unity in regional diversity and multi-cultural exchange ensuring there by national integrity and inter-regional bonding.

This is the reason why 50% seats in every REC were reserved for the state to which it belonged and another 50% of seats were filled up by the students of other states. Actually for each state some seats were reserved in every other states RECs depending upon the population of that state.

In the year 2002, the parliament passed a legislation bringing thereby all the RECs/RITs under the direct purview of India's Federal Government. Again in the year 2007, on the insistence of then HRD minister, Dr. Murli Monohar Joshi, of the Union Government, the parliament passed legislation renaming these collages as NITs and giving them the importance at par with IIT's. Even now half of the intake, in each entry year is drawn from the respective state of NIT itself and the other half is drawn from the rest of India on a common merit list.

As already mentioned earlier admission into NITs till the year 2013, as being done on the basis of the merit list prepared on the score of AIEEE. But from this year i.e., The year 2013 IIT JEE & AIEEE have been combined to a single National Entrance Test for Engineering referred to as JEE the details of which are given below.

ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIADS

What are Science Olympiads?

Olympiads are internationally recognized competitions in various fields of knowledge. They are the highest level examinations

and are hosted by different countries every year. Participation in any of the Olympiads has worldwide recognition and is considered as a great achievement, International Olympiads are held every year in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy and Junior Science.

How do I go to (or participate in) the Physics (or Chemistry or Biology or Astronomy or Jr. Science) Olympiad?

You will have to appear for NSEP (or NSEC / NSEB / NSEA / NSEJS) and then through the Indian National Physics Olympiad (INPhO or INChO or INBO or INAO or INOJS) you may be selected for the further stages of the respective International Olympiad Program.

Is there any other way to go to International Olympiads in these subjects? No! There is none.

How do I enroll myself for any of these?

You must register from your OWN School. The Principal (or Physics or Science Teacher) of your School will enroll you. He will give you all further instructions. In case you have any difficulty then refer to the website www.iapt.org.in. List of all NSE centres of last year (viz 2014-15) is available on the website. The name of contact person at the respective centre is also indicated. Enrollment at the centres only. No direct enrollment.

What are the fees?

Rs 100/= per student per subject (per examination) to be paid in cash to the centre in charge. DO NOT SEND ANY MONEY TO IAPT OFFICE. This exam fee cannot be refunded.

What are the details of the entire selection

Entire selection process is merit based. Following procedure is laid down for the selection of students for the IInd stage (viz) Indian National Olympiads (INOs) of the selection process.

The total number of students who will qualify to appear for second stage Indian National Olympiads (INOs) 2016 will be based on the first stage NSEs 2015 respectively and the following scheme is adopted:

(a) Eligibility Clause: A candidate must secure a score equal to or greater than a Minimum Admissible Score (MAS) to be eligible for the stage II INO exam leading to the International Olympiad. The MAS for given subject will be 40% of the maximum score in that subject.

(b) Proportional Representation Clause: The number of students selected for Stage II (INO) in each subject is around 300. The number of candidates who appeared for NSE in 2014 - 15 in a subject from centres in each State or Union Territory (UT) will be considered the baseline for calculating the number qualifying from centres in that State or UT for that subject. Suppose this number in 2014 - 15 for centres in a given State in a given subject is S, and the total number that appeared in 2014 - 15 in that subject for the country is T, then the number selected to Stage II in that subject from that State would be S/T time 300, rounded off to the nearest higher integer. In the event of a tie at the last position in the list, all students with the same marks at this position will qualify to appear for the Stage II examination. The selected students must nevertheless satisfy the eligibility clause laid out above. The total number to be selected from centres in each State for each subject will be displayed on the IAPT and HBCSE websites.

(c) Minimum Representation Clause: Notwithstanding the proportional representation clause the number of students selected for INO from each State and UT must be at least one, provided that the eligibility clause is satisfied.

(d) Merit Clause: Given the eligibility clause, it is conceivable that 300 students may not qualify for Stage II in a subject. Should this occur, the shortfall (from 300) will be selected based purely on merit without further consideration to Proportional Representation and Minimum Representation Clauses. In the event of a tie at the last position in the list, all students with the same marks at this position will qualify to appear for the Stage II examination.

Individual letters will be sent to these students informing them that they have to appear for Indian National Olympiads (INOs). All these INOs are organized by HOMI BHABHA CENTRE for SCIENCE EDUCATION (HBCSE) Mumbai. TOP 35 students are chosen on the basis of their performance at these INOs. These 35 students in each subject attend the Orientation cum Selection Camp (OCSC) in respective disciplines for about 2 weeks at HOMI BHABHA CENTRE for SCIENCE EDUCATION (HBCSE) Mumbai. The Indian team which is to participate in the International Olympiad is selected from the OCSC in the respective subjects.
